What's our wedding feast? Where in our lives are we striving for that recognition and praise? Who are we trying to impress? And why? These are huge questions. Challenging ones that - with

time, thought and prayerful reflection – likely reveal rich insights from God about ourselves.

So today, let us get on our knees, humble our hearts and ask God to show us our weeds, thankful that with God we'll cultivate more of what's truly good and beautiful.
