

SUNDAY REFLECTION

The teachings of Jesus overflow with direction that can seem almost impossible to live by. “Let go and let God” is one particularly difficult lesson, given our inclination to take control of any personal situation. Often, we only turn to God for help in dire straits and when we have dug a hole too deep for us to escape independently.

The Baptism of the Lord narrative is a straight-forward message about letting go and letting God, in any circumstance. John the Baptist feels unworthy to baptize Jesus and says he should be baptized by Jesus instead. Jesus answers, "Let it be so now; for it is proper for us in this way to fulfill all righteousness." Fulfilling all righteousness is living God's will. The baptism of a sinless Jesus reveals his human side and his desire to be right with God, all the while foreshadowing his mortal death on the cross in atonement for the sins of humanity.

In his humanity, Jesus later questions God's will by asking if death on the cross could be avoided, similar to the way we seek alternative solutions to those offered by God. Jesus acquiesced to God's will, showing us how to seek and pray for God's help in the most trying of times. In doing so, we too are the beloved with whom God is well pleased. *Excerpt from Living with Christ.*

The Small Signs

The presence of God is often subtle, small, quiet, and hidden. "A shoot shall sprout from the stump of Jesse, and from his roots a bud shall blossom" (Isa. 11:1-2 NAB). Our salvation comes from something small, tender, and vulnerable, something hardly noticeable. The Lord, who is the creator of the universe, comes to us in smallness, weakness, and hiddenness. Kindergarten Registration at Wellington Catholic DSB

The Wellington Catholic District School Board is now accepting new registrations for Kindergarten students! Our two-year Kindergarten program allows our young learners to learn, grow, and explore through play and inquiry in a faith-based environment.

Children who were born in 2022 may attend Year One Kindergarten (Junior Kindergarten), and children born in 2021 may attend Year Two Kindergarten (Senior Kindergarten). If your child is currently attending Year One with Wellington Catholic DSB, you do not have to re-register for Year Two at the same school.

We invite families to register their child for Kindergarten by following these steps:

- Find your school.** Visit findmyschool.ca find your local Catholic school using your home address
- Pre-Register.** Complete the [online pre-registration form](http://wellingtoncdsb.ca) available at wellingtoncdsb.ca. Once submitted, you will receive a unique registration code by email. Use the code and link provided to complete the online registration forms
- Schedule a meeting with school administration.** Book a meeting with the school to meet the staff, submit required documents, and finalize your child's admission
