SUNDAY REFLECTION

Our challenge that the Gospel writers leave with us is that they generally don't fill out their stories; we hear only the bare bones. In today's Gospel, we are not told about

Jesus' facial expression or tone of voice or inner thoughts. Jesus' friends try to dissuade him from attending to the foreigner. Jesus ignores them; but what was Jesus thinking when he refers to the Canaanite woman and her daughter as dogs? What were his tone and facial expression? Was he teasing her? Or perhaps testing her faith?

To most of us, Jesus would seem shockingly rude, and the woman's persistence all the more remarkable. She might have walked away in a huff. Why does she demean herself by continuing her plea? The answer, of course, lies in her great love for her daughter and her conviction that Jesus is a holy person with healing powers. I imagine that Jesus' voice conveyed immense kindness the second time he spoke. Today's readings make clear that God's saving grace and care are for all nationalities, races and religions, not only for Jews or Christians. How do we respond to the outsider? Like the disciples, do we avoid acknowledging or being generous to needy strangers? Or do we emulate Jesus? And do we, like the woman, confidently bring the needs of those we love to Jesus? *Excerpt from Living with Christ*.

Let God Love You the Way God Wants

I know that true joy comes from letting God love me the way God wants, whether it is through illness or health, failure or success, poverty or wealth, rejection or praise. It is hard for me to say, "I shall gratefully accept everything, Lord, that pleases you. Let your will be done." But I know that when I truly believe my Father is pure love, it will become increasingly possible to say these words from the heart. Charles de Foucauld once wrote a prayer of abandonment that expresses beautifully the spiritual attitude, I wish I had.

Father, I abandon myself into your hands, do with me what you will. Whatever you may do, I thank you; I am ready for all, I accept all. Let only your will be done in me, and in all your creatures.

I wish no more than this, O Lord.

It seems good to pray this prayer often. These are words of a holy man, and they show the way I must go. I realize that I can never make this prayer come true by my own efforts.
