#### SUNDAY REFLECTION

Every morning I pray for the grace to recognize their face of God in each person I will encounter that day. Does that include someone who disagrees with me, or dislikes me or even seeks to harm me?

Jesus' teaching in today's Gospel is clear and uncompromising: "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." These are surely among the most challenging words in Scripture!

The catastrophic experiences which define our contemporary world – a global pandemic, the growing climate crisis, deep-seated racism and other forms of hatred – all bring to light the divisions among people and societies, differences which may seem insurmountable.

I think what Jesus is challenging us to do today is to break down the barriers that divide us. The magnitude of the crises facing our world requires that we overcome our differences in order to work together on solutions. We will never agree on everything, but to see the Other as a human being beloved of God rather than demonizing them as the "enemy" is a good first step. In fact, a loved enemy is no longer an enemy! As much as we may disagree with someone's position or disapprove of their actions, we are nevertheless called to recognize them as a cherished child of God. Authentic discipleship requires no less. Except from Living with Christ.

# MEDITATIONS – HENRI NOUWEN SOCIETY – Claim Your Truth

It seems crucial that you realize deeply that your worth and value does not depend on anyone else. You have to claim your own inner truth. You are a person worth being loved and called to give love, not because anyone says so . . . but because you are created out of love and live in the embrace of a God who didn't hesitate to send his only son to die for us. . . . Your being good and worthy of love does not depend on any human being. You have to keep saying to yourself: "I am being loved by an unconditional, unlimited love and that love allows me to be a free person, center of my own actions and decisions." The more you can come to realize this, the more you will be able to forgive those who have hurt you and love them in their brokenness. Without a deep feeling of self-respect, you cannot forgive and will always feel anger, resentment, and revenge. The greatest human act is forgiveness: "Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who have sinned against us." Forgiveness stands in the center of God's love for us and also in the center of our love for each other. Loving one another means forgiving one another over and over again.
