Other masses designated for this novena are; **December 16th** at 5:00 pm, **December 17th** at 12:00 noon, **December 18th** to December **22nd** at 7:00 pm and Saturday, **December 23rd** at 5:00 pm.

. The traditional Christmas custom of "Simbang Gabi" in the Philippines, is a devotional 9-day novena (series of masses),

practiced by Roman Catholics in anticipation and preparation for the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to honour our Blessed Mother. "*Simbang Gabi*" is not just an old custom that is celebrated because we want to, but rather it is a way of asking "favor or blessings" from the Lord, as it is believed that if one completes the whole series of nine masses, prayers and/or intentions will be granted. There will be breaking of bread and fellowship at the church hall following each **Simbang Gabi** masses. Everyone is welcome to join this 9-day mass novena/celebration at St. Joseph's to experience an old but popular Filipino tradition. Hope you can join us.
